### **Collect**

O God,  
who, by the guidance of a star,  
revealed your only-begotten Son to the nations:  
Grant that we, who know you now by faith,  
may at the last be led to see your glory face to face;  
through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord,  
who lives and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, world without end.

10 Sun      **First Sunday after Epiphany: THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD** [2] (DP Festivals)[White]

### **Collect**

Eternal Father,  
who at the baptism of Jesus revealed him to be your Son,  
anointing him with the Holy Spirit:  
grant that we, being born again,  
and made your children by adoption and grace,  
may daily be renewed by your Holy Spirit;  
through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord,  
who lives and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, world without end.

Genesis 1:1-5; Psalm 29; Acts 19:1-7; Mark 1:4-11

Almighty and eternal God,  
ruler of heaven and earth:  
mercifully hear the prayers of your people,  
and grant your peace to our times;  
through Jesus Christ, our Lord,  
who lives and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, world without end.

24 Sun      **Third Sunday after Epiphany** [3][Green]

**Collect**

Almighty and eternal God,  
behold us in our weakness:  
and stretch out your hands to protect us;  
through Jesus Christ, our Lord,  
who lives and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, world without end.

**Readings**

Jonah 3:1-5, 10; Psalm 62:5-12; 1 Corinthians 7:29-31; Mark 1:14-20

31 Sun      **THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD** [2](DP Festivals)  
[White] (transferred from 2<sup>nd</sup> February)

**Collect**

Almighty and Everlasting God:  
as your Only-begotten Son was presented  
and received in the temple,  
so may we welcome and proclaim him as the light of the nations  
and the glory of your people;  
who lives and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, world without end.

**Readings**

Malachi 3:1-4; Psalm 84 or Psalm 24:7-10; Hebrews 2:14-18; Luke 2:22-40
